# FEATURED MEMBER OF THE MONTH: LAURENE AND DON ELLIOTT



My deceased wife, Agnes, and I had been snowbirds in Arizona off and on since the 60's. In 1995, we bought a home in Phase II of Sun City and started spending six months every year in Sun City. Since the late sixties, I owned a 1924 Model T Roadster similar to the one I had in High School in 1945 during World War II. Two brothers in Denver were restoring this car when we happened to be in Denver for a convention and were returning to Wichita, Kansas where I was employed as an electronics engineer for the Boeing Company.

We bought the car from the brothers with the understanding they would deliver it to Wichita when the restorations was finished. That is how I acquired the current Model T Ford I now have. We had the car shipped out to Arizona around 1996. The restored paint job had become crazed and I had Bruce Mercer in Sun City West repaint the whole car. The car still has that paint job to his day with the color combination the car was originally restored with (dark blue body with black fenders). To this day the car is all original (coils, timer, generator, starter) except for the paint scheme (the original 1924 Model T was all black, I'm sure).

In High School in 1945, I took shop just so I could overhaul my Model T Ford. I might mention that I had sold my original 1924 Model T and acquired a 1920 Model T, which is the one I overhauled in High School Shop. One thing I did not get repaired when the magneto was torn down was checking out the coils and magnets on the flywheel. As a result, the magneto never worked, and because I did not have a 6 volt lead acid battery to put in the car, I used a Hot Shot Battery to run the coils on the car. When the Hot Shot on one battery would get low, I put two Hot Shot batteries in parallel. I lived in the small town of WaKeeney, Kansas and when I went to my first year of college, I drove the Model T 150 miles to Lindsborg, Kansas (yes, the Hot Shot batteries got me there). I had that car until the end of my first year of college, when I sold it to a person in Ellis, Kansas.

I remarried in 2010 and my new wife Laurene and I still show the Model T when possible. We are not sure how much longer we can show the Model T, but hope to do so as long as possible. We have considered selling it, but I know I would hate to part with it after all these years.
