## President's November Letter (2017)

**PLEASE NOTE:** Time continues to go by and we as a Club continue to survive. As I indicated last month, we have several very important issues facing us in the last half of 2017. The most important issues for our Club are the future vacancies of the Executive Board and the Members of the Governing Board. As most of you know, we have not been able to fill the vacancy of the Vice President for this current year. Getting new people to fill the current and upcoming Positions of the Full Governing Board is of major importance to the future of our Cars Club.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Again, one possible way to help offset an individual's concern about taking on a leadership role is to serve as an assistant for one year with the thought of taking the position for the following year. For example, for the President's position, he/she could become an assistant to the President and work very closely with the President to learn the needs of the Position. For the Vice President's position, the current President could aid the person in learning the needs for the Vice President's position. Please feel free to offer your thoughts and suggestions on this matter.

**WE NEED YOUR HELP:** Our Annual Business Meeting will be held in early November. At this Annual Business Meeting, the 4 members of the Executive Board Members will be elected (President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer). Following the election of the Executive Board Members, the President, for next year, will seek out and appoint the Chairperson for the seven Standing Committees (Car Show Procurement, Car Show Coordinator, Car Show Setup, Activities, Web Page/Newsletter, Regalia, and Past President). Additionally, the President appoints a Directory Coordinator and a Sunshine Coordinator (non-voting members assisting the Full Board of Directors).

If any Member needs to have a New Car reviewed by the Governing Board prior to it being shown at a Car Show, please bring it to a Board Meeting (9:30am on the fourth Monday of each month) for review. If this creates a hardship for anyone, please contact me (309-453-3906) and I will attempt to have your Car reviewed some other way. New Members wanting to join our Club will bring their Show Car to one of the Boards' regular meetings for review of their Show Car and for the Board to talk with them prior to voting on their joining our C.A.R.S. Club.

Russ is working on new Car Shows for the remainder of this year and on into next year. I have about five new Cars and owner interested in joining our CARS Club. I hope to have all of them joining us by the end of this year.

As always, I look forward to serving you and seek your help and input so that our CARS Club can continue and improve. Your Club needs your advice and help.
