President's September Letter (2017)

We are now headed into the last half of 2017. We have several very important issues facing us in the last half of 2017. The most important issues for our Club are the future vacancies of the Executive Board and the Members of the Governing Board. As most of you know, we have not been able to fill the vacancy of the Vice President for this current year. Furthermore, I have been President for three years, the Secretary has been in Office for 5 years and the Treasurer has been in Office for over 6 years. All of us who are currently serving on the Executive Board should be replaced. Naturally, we would love to have new ideas with added enthusiasm replace us. Various ones of the Executive Board have been making comments about not continuing as an Executive Board Member. For the betterment of our Car Club, we need 'new blood' to step forward and fill these positions. Likewise, many of the appointed Chairpersons have served in their respective positions for many years and would like to have a rest. For example, Rip Fenner has been in charge of the Web Page and News Letter for many years and would like to step aside and let someone else take his place. George Stout has been in charge of Regalia for many years and would also like to take a break. Judy Stout is currently serving as Chairperson for the Activities Committee and took that position in March only because I could not find anyone else to cover the job. Judy has served on the Activities Committee in the past. Filling the Positions of the Full Governing Board is of major importance to the future of our Cars Club.

I don't know the answer to this major dilemma that is facing our Car's Club. I do, however, believe that we have many capable people in our Club who would do a great job if they would only step forward. One possible way to help offset an individual's concern about taking on a leadership role is to serve as an assistant for one year with the thought of taking the position for the following year. For example, for the President's position, he/she could become an assistant to the President and work very closely with the President to learn the needs of the Position. For the Vice President's position, the current President could aid the person in learning the needs for the Vice President's position. With respect to the Secretary's and Treasurer's positions, the respective individuals could become an assistant to the current Secretary and Treasurer for a year. For the seven appointed Chairmanship positions, an assistant can be appointed by the President to work closely with Chairperson of the appropriate Committee. This would allow a person to become familiar with the Committee prior to becoming the Chairperson. There may be other ways that that we could accomplish the same objective. Please feel free to offer your thoughts and suggestions on this matter.

Our Annual Business Meeting will be held in early November. At this Annual Business Meeting, the 4 members of the Executive Board Members will be elected (President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer). Following the election of the Executive Board Members, the President, for next year, will seek out and appoint the Chairperson for the seven Standing Committees (Car Show Procurement, Car Show Coordinator, Car Show Setup, Activities, Web Page/Newsletter, Regalia, and Past President). Additionally, the President appoints a Directory Coordinator and a Sunshine Coordinator (non-voting members assisting the Full Board of Directors).

I greatly appreciate your very, very strong consideration of this extremely serious matter facing the future of our C.A.R.S. Club of Sun Cities. If this Club fails for lack of leadership, there will be many people who will not have a Cars Club to call home since they do not live in Sun City or Sun City West.

If any Member needs to have a New Car reviewed by the Governing Board prior to it being shown at a Car Show, please bring it to a Board Meeting (9:30am on the fourth Monday of each month) for review. If this creates a hardship for anyone, please contact me (309-453-3906) and I will attempt to have your Car reviewed some other way.

Russ is already lining up some small Car Shows in September/October. We hopefully will not attempt to have any larger Car Shows until October or later. I look forward to seeing all of you as the fall season continues.

As always, I look forward to serving you and seek your help and input so that our CARS Club can continue and improve. Your Club needs your advice and help.

What's Cooking?

Cobbler cake in a Mason jar

With cake in a jar, there's no need to make the batter to pour into the jar. Simply spoon the raw ingredients into the jars, add a slice of butter on top and watch the magic happen in the oven. Then serve the tasty treats right from the jar. Here are two variations of my new favorite single-serving sensation. ■

Cobbler Cake in a Jar

For 4 half-pint Mason jars:

- 3 cups fresh or frozen fruits in season
- 3/4 cup flour
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 4 tablespoons butter
- Whipped cream for topping
- 1 package dried beans

Directions:

In a bowl, mix together fruits of choice equaling 3 cups. Pour equal amounts of the fruit in each of the four jars. In another bowl, mix together flour, sugar and salt until well combined. Pour equal amounts of dry ingredients on top of the fruit. Add one tablespoon of butter on top of dry ingredients. Place the four jars into a square baking dish, a few inches apart. Spread dried beans



around the jars to keep them steady while you're moving them in and out of the oven. Bake at 350 degrees for about 45 minutes. Remove from oven and allow cakes to cool. When cooled, twist on lids and refrigerate until ready to serve. Top with a dollop of whipped cream.

Half-Pint One-Pan Éclair:

For delicious cakes in a jar that don't need baking, try the half-pint éclair!

Place a graham cracker on the bottom of each jar. Combine one small box of vanilla pudding and one cup of milk, mixing until thickened. Add 1/2 small tub of Cool Whip and mix until well blended. Spoon a dollop

on graham cracker. Repeat process until layers are just below the neckline. Melt one container of chocolate fudge frosting in microwave for about 45 seconds. Pour several tablespoons of melted frosting over the top of each jar of graham cracker layers. Refrigerate for 24 hours to soften graham crackers before serving.

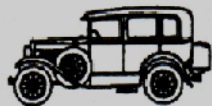
